### Lile na hÉireann

Rugadh Gráinne, an bhean ba cháiliúla ar fad de mhuintir Mháille, ar Chliara.

#### The Lily of Ireland

Seventh century Irish princess, Dymphna, devoted her short life to Christ. Maddened by grief after his wife's death, her father Damon wanted to marry Dymphna. He pursued her across Ireland to Achill where she had founded a monastery at nearby Kildavnet. Dymphna escaped but Damon finally caught up with her in Belgium and cut off her head.

#### The sea queen of Connacht

The O'Malleys were the seafaring chieftains of south-west Mayo. They made their money from trade, piracy and taxing boats sailing through their waters. They built a string of forts including the one at Kildavnet to protect the narrow channel between Achill and the mainland. Grace, the most famous O'Malley, was born on Clare Island.
